Sunday School Plan

General

Sunday School will begin on September 13

Sunday School will begin at 9:45 am each Sunday.

Curriculums are available at the book room.

Families bringing children to Sunday School are welcome to stay at church during Sunday School and visit in the space where they are scheduled to attend church that Sunday.

Grades 1-8

Children of families scheduled to be at church as part of a janitor group, song leader, usher, preacher, or sound committee will attend Sunday School.

Children not scheduled to be at church each week should be taught the weekly lesson at home that week.

Those families in the dining room will have their children attend the appropriate grade class on the south side of the classrooms (The corridor near the front of church).

Those families in the sanctuary will have their children attend the appropriate grade class on the north side of the classrooms (the corridor near the back of church).

Grade 9

All children in grade nine are invited to attend Sunday School and church each week.

One parent should bring the child and is invited to stay for church if the family isn't already scheduled to be there as part of the normal rotation.

Sunday School Teachers

For grades 1-8, two teachers should be present for each classroom each week. Scheduling should be handled among the teachers for that grade. If a teacher is scheduled to help teach but isn't scheduled to be at church, they should return home following Sunday School and receive the patch at home.

Parking

Once Sunday School starts those attending church in the sanctuary each week should park in the back of the church and enter the building through the back doors.

Those attending in the dining room should park in the front of the building and enter the building through the main front doors.
