Old Apostolic Lutheran Church of Vanderhoof Sunday Service Update

The board of trustees, with guidance, has put together a plan for the congregation to return to attending church services. This plan is based on current provincial orders.

The plan has enough occupancy for approximately one third of the congregation to attend church each Sunday. Seating in the sanctuary will be spaced so each family can safely distance.

Church services will begin at 11:00 AM with the church doors being open 20 minutes before service and closed 20 minutes after the service has ended.

Access into the building will be limited to the East entrance. The phone patch services will be in place for all those that are not attending church and will be sent out in its current fashion. If you have been ill or may have been exposed, please stay home. If you are not comfortable attending church due to health or illness concerns, the phone patch will remain available. Parents or others are asked to attend to small children that cannot understand physical distancing. Please talk to your children about physical distancing and inform them of the current guidelines in place.

All those attending church services are asked to abide by the following Provincial guidelines:

- 1. The number of people in a confined area at any time must be limited to allow for adequate distancing between households.
- 2. A 6 foot distance must be maintained between household groups at all times.
- 4. No food or drink shall be served. This includes all drinking fountains, coffee pots etc.
- 5. Refrain from hand shaking
- 6. Sanitize your hands upon entry of building

Groups will be asked to clean and sanitize the building after the Sunday they attended.

Sunday school will not be held at church. Please continue Sunday school at home.
